**Order of Dismissal as to Third Coast Produce Company, Ltd.
and
Order Setting Hearing Date**

This action was commenced on November 2, 2013 by the filing of a “Petition for Review of PACA Division Determination” with the caption In re: Third Coast Produce Company, Ltd., George Finch and John D. (Dennis) Honeycutt and was assigned a primary Docket Number of 13-0067. Examination of the Petition indicates that the action is in fact a petition for review of a determination by the Chief of the Perishable

Agricultural Commodities Act (PACA) Branch, Fruit and Vegetable Programs, Agricultural Marketing Service, United States Department of Agriculture that George Finch and John D. (Dennis) Honeycutt were responsibly connected to Third Coast Produce Company, Ltd. when it violated the PACA and that inclusion of Third Coast Produce Company, Ltd. as a party is not necessary for the review of the determinations.

Accordingly, Third Coast Produce Company, Ltd. is **DISMISSED** as a party to the review of the responsibly connection determinations concerning Petitioners Finch and Honeycutt, the caption will be amended to reflect that Dismissal and the action will proceed with the above identified Docket Numbers.

A Status Report has been filed indicating that the parties are agreeable to having the case heard in Washington, DC and identifying mutually agreeable dates. The two cases will be consolidated for hearing and are set for oral hearing to commence at **9:00 AM Local Time on Tuesday, August 13, 2013** in the United States Department of Agriculture Courtroom, Room 1037, South Building, 1400 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC.
