**Order**

This matter is before the Administrative Law Judge upon the Motion of the Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service to Lift Suspension imposed by the Default Decision and Order entered by me on June 3, 2010. Paragraph 3 of the Order contained in the Default Decision and Order suspended the Respondent's license for a period of 30 days and thereafter until the Respondent demonstrated that he is in compliance with the Animal Welfare Act (Act), as amended 7 U.S.C. §2131, *et seq.* and the regulations and standards promulgated thereunder. 9 C.F.R. §1.1 *et seq.*

The Administrator's Motion indicates that as of October 6, 2010, the Respondent passed an inspection with no non-compliant items and satisfactorily participated in the exit interview.

Being sufficiently advised, the 30 day and continuing suspension imposed in my Default Decision and Order is **LIFTED** and the Respondent may continue business on the premises.
